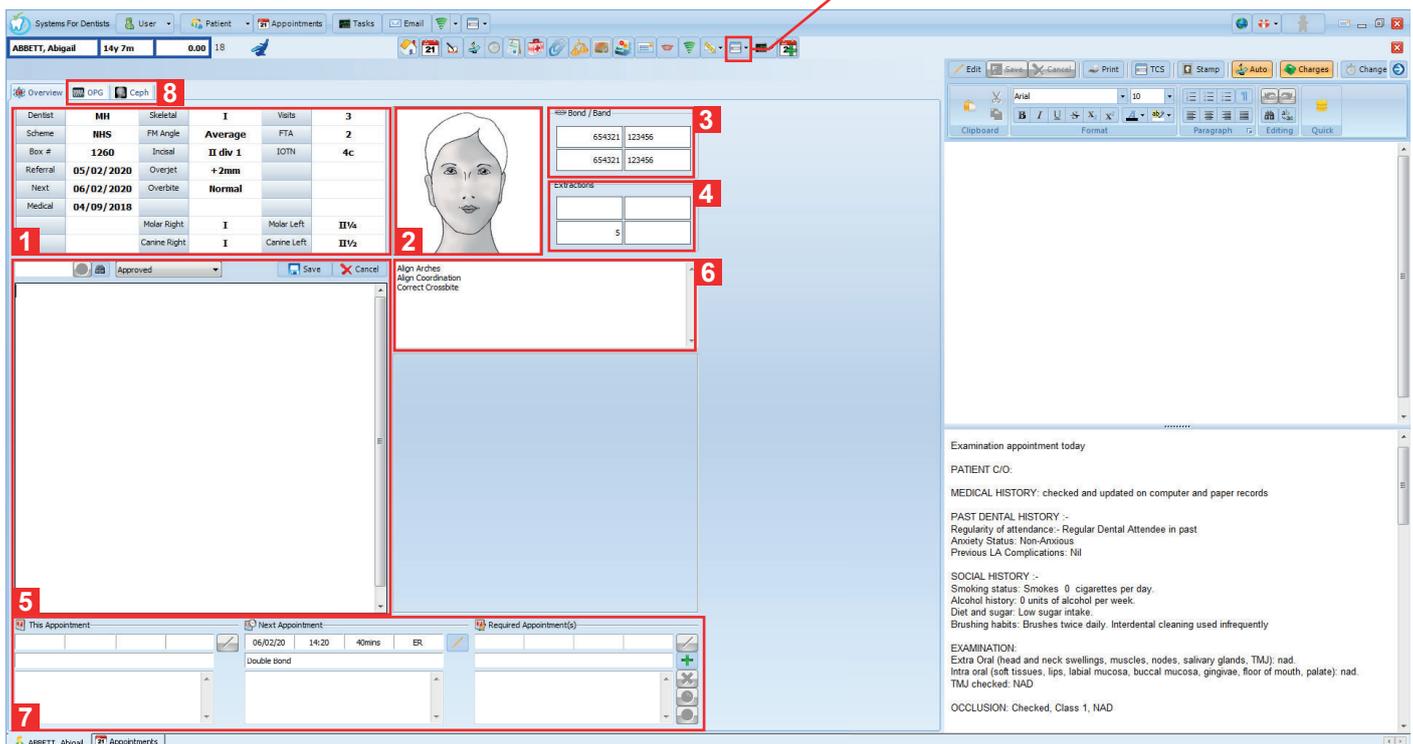


## Orthodontic Overview

To reflect the needs and requirements for our Orthodontic customers, we have developed a Patient Overview screen to provide key data relevant to the patient record that you are working with.

You are able to access this screen by selecting the Overview option from this  button, which is available when you have a patient record open.

Or by pressing the F5 key

The following information is available from the Patient Overview screen:

- 1 Key patient data – including the patient's scheme, box number as well as key measurements.
- 2 Patient's image
- 3 Teeth Banded/Bonded
- 4 Teeth to be extracted
- 5 Actions and quick text that can be added to the record
- 6 Objectives
- 7 Appointment details including:
  - Details of the current appointment; details of the next appointment; and details of appointment requests added to the Appointment Clipboard.
  - You can use the  button to edit appointment details, or you can use the  button to add additional appointment requests.
- 8 OPG and Ceph images are available via the tabs at the top of the screen, these will display images that have been marked as 'OPG' or 'Ceph' from the Images screen in the patient record.
